Inetum secures a strategic project to modernize the HR function of the French Ministry of the Armed Forces

- Inetum has been selected to modernize the information system of the Pensions and Occupational Risks Department (SPRP) of the French Ministry of the Armed Forces.
- The ESPRIT project, which has just been launched, aims to improve the management of disability pensions.
